Sun Safety

Please remember the four S's to help our children cope with the warm weather and to be safe when they are playing outside:

SLIP – slip on a shirt

SLAP – slap on a hat (children will not be allowed to play outside on a sunny day without a hat as from Tuesday 6th June)

SLOP – slop on your sun cream (Factor 15 or above – please apply before children come to school)

SLURP – slurp plenty of water

Research has shown how important drinking water throughout the day can be for both levels of concentration, behaviour and all round good health. Children and adults should be drinking a litre of water throughout the day and they are encouraged at school to take water breaks and fill up their water bottles from the filter water cooler outside the main hall. On the 25th May, 2018 the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will be applicable and the current Data Protection Act (DPA) will be updated by a new Act giving effect to its provisions.

Thomas Reade Primary School complies with the GDPR and is registered as a 'Data Controller' with the Information Commissioner's Office Registration No ZA183694.

We need to hold personal information about your child on our computer system and in paper records to help us with their educational needs.

The School collects and uses personal information to enable School staff to have access to your child's records to perform their professional duties. From time to time information may be shared with others involved in your child's care, if it is necessary. Anyone with access to your child's records is properly trained in confidentiality issues and is governed by a legal duty to keep their details secure, accurate and up to date.

All information about your child is held securely and appropriate safeguards are in place to prevent accidental loss.

In some circumstances we may be required by law to release your child's details to statutory or other official bodies, for example, if a court order is presented, or in the case of public educational issues. In other circumstances you may be required to give written consent before information is released – such as the educational reports for insurance, solicitors etc.

To ensure your child's privacy, we will not disclose information over the telephone unless we are sure that we are talking to you - the parent/carer. Information will not be disclosed to family and friends unless we have prior written consent and we do not leave messages with others.

You will have already received the Photograph/Video Permission Form. Please ensure this is signed and returned to the school office. It is important to remember that the Health and Safety and the Safeguarding of your child out ways the GDPR Regulations.

Parking

Please ensure when parking around the school that you park to ensure the safety of our children. You must not bring your car onto the school site at any time. Your car must not obstruct the school gates, pathways and our neighbour's driveways. You will notice a new white line on the corner of Grundy Close. If you park on this white line a parking ticket will be issued. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE CORNER OF GRUNDY CLOSE – THIS IS VERY DANGEROUS TO PEDESTRIANS AND DRIVERS.**
